What is StreetGames?

StreetGames is a national charity, established in 2006, to help promote sport for young people living in disadvantaged communities. Up and down the country, StreetGames is delivering sport and dance to young people where they want it, at times when they want it and in a style they want.

What is the Tees Valley Festival?

How do I register a Group / Individual?

- All competitors will automatically be entered into the 'Mini Olympics'.
- Young people not taking part in the competitions are welcome to attend just for the 'Mini Olympics'.

As group leader you also need to complete a consent form for each young person attending the Festival. **This must be brought on the day in order for the person to take part.**
