Protecting Personal Information with Powerful Security Features

We've built systems to defend against security threats and help people maintain control of their information.

- **Two-Factor Authentication** – This provides extra protection against unauthorized use of your account. Enter a secure code whenever you log in to Facebook from a new device to help us confirm it's really you (currently US-only). **NEW**
- **Social Authentication** – Instead of a traditional CAPTCHA, use pictures of your friends to make your experience more secure. Social authentication brings social design to

information security.

- **HTTPS** – Establish a secure connection to Facebook when you're uncertain about the security of your network or if you are using public wifi access.
- **Remote Session Management** – Monitor your open sessions and log out remotely from open sessions anywhere in the world.
- **Login Notifications** – Receive notifications whenever your account is accessed from a new device.
- **One-Time Passwords** – Text "otp" to FBOOK (32665) any time you're unsure of the security of the computer you're using. Facebook will send you a temporary password that can be used only once and will expire in 20 minutes (currently US-only).

Fostering Safety, Online and Offline

We are committed to promoting safety, both on Facebook and around the globe. We provide tools directly to the community and work with law enforcement to keep people safe.

- **Reporting Infrastructure** – Links on almost every page of Facebook enable people to easily report inappropriate or offensive content.
- **Social Reporting** – People can report bullying, impostor profiles, and other safety issues simultaneously to Facebook and to a trusted adult who can help them resolve issues face to face. **NEW**
- **Broadcasting AMBER Alerts** – We've partnered with organizations like the National Center for Missing and Exploited Children and the Royal Canadian Mountain Police to broadcast AMBER Alerts on Facebook.
- **Global Disaster Relief on Facebook** – When disaster strikes, we use this special page to post updates, share resources and spotlight disaster response efforts taking place on Facebook.
